## Berthing Application Form Replacement - PIMS



- GeelongPort are replacing the current ASDEQ Forms in November, the existing system has become end of life with the supplier decommissioning ASDEQ in December.
- The new portal is the first step in a GeelongPort Port Information Management System (PIMS) is aimed at streamlining the process for berthing applications allowing for the following
  - Prefill of agent data based off your login details
  - Agent profile data such as key contact details can be updated
  - Vessel lookup and prefill of data (dimensions and GRT)
  - Ability to save applications as a draft and come back to edit
  - Ability to clone previously submitted applications
  - Forms are editable up to 2 days prior to ETA
  - Cargo manifest now linked to the form, no spreadsheet uploads required
  - Removal of the required to physical sign the application, note you are still bound by the terms upon form submission by entering your name

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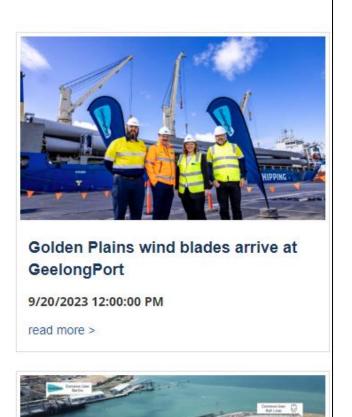
# GeelongPort is Victoria's second largest port located within Victoria's largest regional city, Geelong.

**Draft Voyages** 

Any Berthing Application not submitted will stay in the draft voyages section, this is the default entry point upon login



**Submitted Voyages** 

All fully submitted forms and any vessels in port are in this category. Forms in this category can be edited with regards to Port Services up to 48 hours prior to arrival



**Berthed Voyages** 

Vessels due to arrive in less than 48 hours are in this category, these Vessels can have Cargo Manifests submitted



**Closed Voyages** 

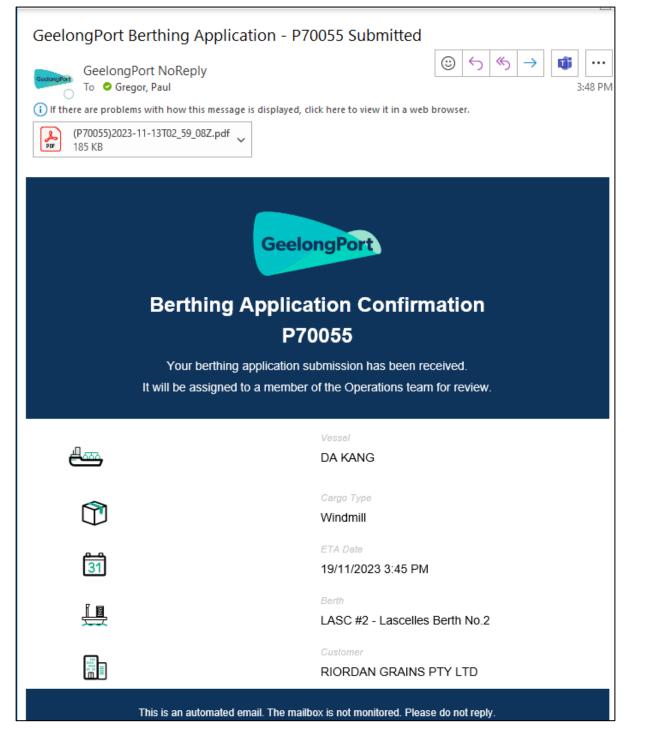
Vessels that have left port and have had cargo manifests submitted are in this category

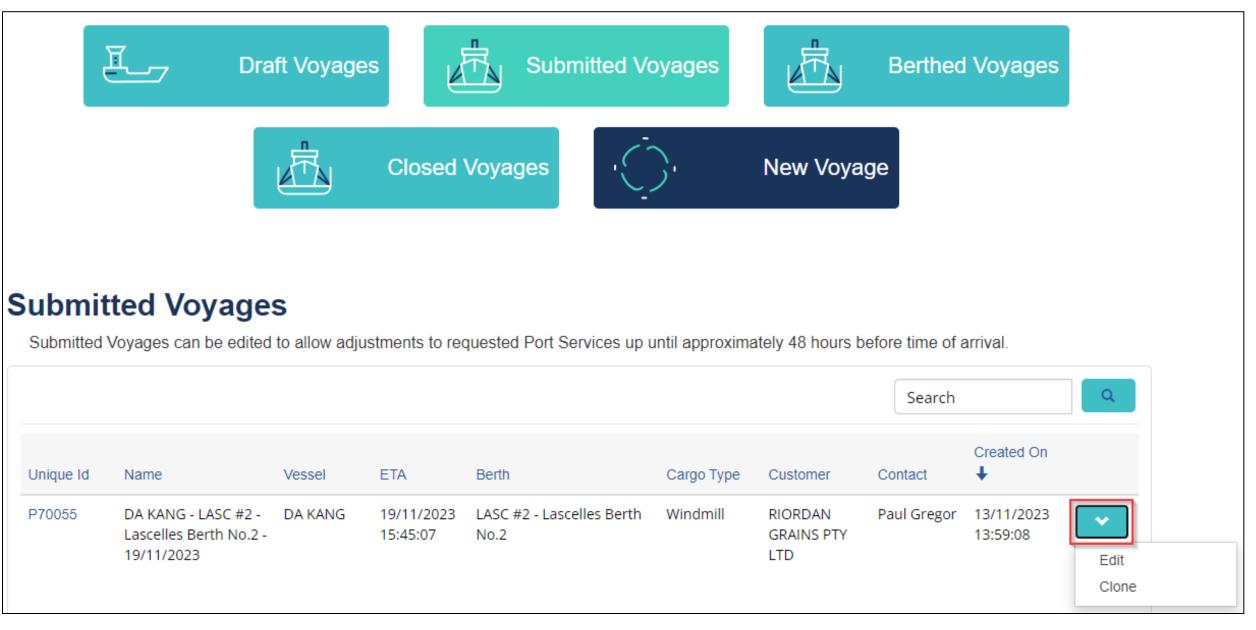
### PIMS Form Submission

Once a voyage is submitted it can be edited up to 48 hours prior to ETA. Fields editable include ETA, ETD and Port Services such as water, lights storage and laydown.

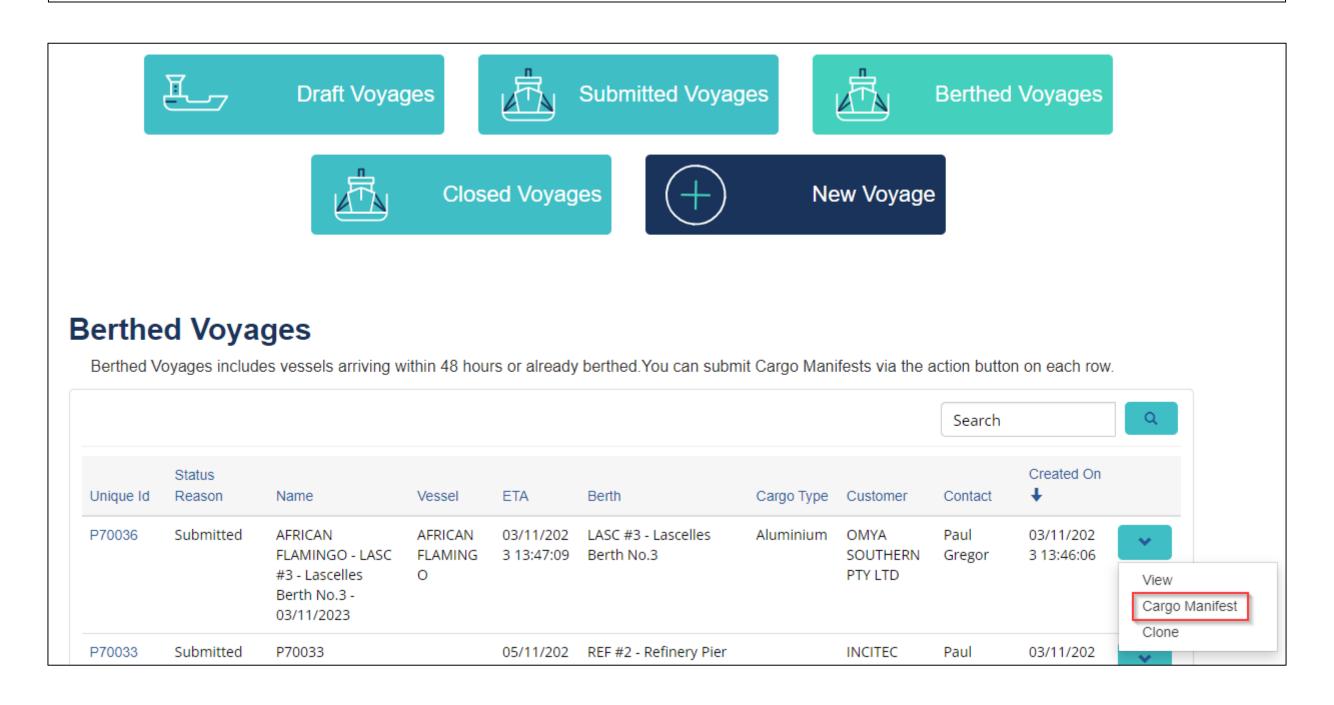




### PIMS Cargo Manifest
